Our 4<sup>th</sup> grade studies program includes a short presentation to your class(es) in the Mission Church, followed by touring of the museum and grounds at your own pace. Picnic grounds with tables are available for lunch before heading back. (You can plan a total of 2 ½ hours for your visit.)

**Who:** Red and White Track students ONLY, and siblings. No friends of students allowed.  
Focus Grade Levels: 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grades. All grades are welcome to attend.

**Cost:** Student Fee: \$4.00  
Adult Fee: \$4.00  
Sibling Fee: \$4.00 (5 years old and under are free)

- Students must wear their SRA uniform and follow the SRA behavior code.
- Please arrive 15 minutes prior to scheduled tour so I can check you in.
- If you are late you may not be admitted.
- Parents must provide transportation
- Parents must stay and chaperone

4. Merge onto **I-215 S** 12.8 mi



5. **I-215 S** becomes **I-15 S**. 15.3 mi



6. Take the **CA-76** exit, **EXIT 46**, toward **Pala/Oceanside**. 0.6 mi



7. Turn **right** onto **Pala Rd/CA-76**. Continue to follow **CA-76 W**.  
*If you reach I-15 S you've gone about 0.2 miles too far* 12.9 mi



8. Turn **right** onto **Rancho del Oro Dr**.  
*Rancho del Oro Dr is 0.6 miles past Old Grove Rd  
If you reach Douglas Dr you've gone about 0.4 miles too far* 0.2 mi



9. Turn **right** onto **Mission Ave**.  
*If you reach the end of Peyri Dr you've gone a little too far* 0.05 mi
